

Summer School 2010 Information:

Junior High

All junior high summer school classes will be at Mae Hensley Junior High School or at Blaker Kinser Junior High School.

Dates: June 7 – July 2

The Ceres Unified School District will be offering a Summer School Program for students currently enrolled in grades 6 and 7. This program is strongly recommended for students who have failed to meet the promotion requirements established by CUSD. The program will be a four-week session from June 7 through July 2, 2010.

Transition Class

Incoming 7th graders will be offered Pre-Algebra Readiness and ELA Readiness classes that will help students become familiar with junior high expectations. Students will rotate through each of these classes each day. This will help them become familiar with the campus, as well as circulating through multiple classes on a daily basis.

Upon completion of these classes, students will receive 7.5 elective credits for the upcoming 2010-2011 school year. In order to obtain credit for the classes, students must have attended at least 75% of the time.
