High School

All high school summer school classes will be at Ceres High School.

Session 1 – June 6 – June 21

Session 2 – June 21 – July 8 (no school July 4th)

Transition Class:

To ease the transition from junior high school to high school, CUSD will be offering a transitional class this summer for incoming 9th graders at Ceres and Central Valley High Schools. In this class students will learn:

- Algebra and English Language Arts preparation skills for the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE).
- High School graduation requirements, expectations and different programs offered
- Expectations when entering the workforce that will include field trips to local businesses and guest speakers.
- College expectations that will include guest speakers and fieldtrips to MJC and CSU Stanislaus.

Upon successful completion of the class, students will receive 5 elective credits.
