### Understand your rights!

No matter where you live or how long you have lived there, your child has a right to go to school and receive a free appropriate public education. In Ceres Unified School District, if you move from one place to another, you may have certain rights:

- If you don't have a permanent address, you can ask for a Project Easement Student Residency Questionnaire when enrolling your child.
- You have a right to keep your child in the school of original enrollment.
- Your child cannot be kept out of school if you lack documents needed for enrollment.
- You are eligible to apply for preschool services if you have a preschool-aged child.
- You may be eligible to receive additional community resources.
